



At Elizabeth Seton Children's, we derive inspiration from the extraordinary children we care for and love each day. In 2019, that inspiration took us to new heights.

The year marked a turning point for us as we reorganized ourselves under a new unified brand, tying the work of our three organizations together through our namesake, St. Elizabeth Seton. With this fresh and cohesive identity, our organizations have been able to more effectively tell the story of who we are, the needs of our children and families and why our work is important. In doing so, we captured new audiences within the communities we serve, across New York State and even throughout the country.

In 2019, we set our sights on solving the most urgent crisis upon us at the time: the aging out of our young adults from Elizabeth Seton Children's Center. Building on the foundation we laid last year, we continue to strive toward our goal of raising funds to establish the first ever young adult center that provides specialized programming and care to individuals ages 21 and older who live with complex medical conditions.

The year 2019 was the launching pad to the future of our organization. Then came 2020 ...

It goes without saying that this year has been the most difficult in our history. Yet, we have never wavered in our commitment to give our all to each child and provide them with opportunities to live their lives to the fullest. Through the hard work and fortitude of our heroic staff and supporters, we have not had a single case of COVID-19 among our 169 precious children who reside at Elizabeth Seton Children's Center as of this writing. This is the Elizabeth Seton Children's miracle of 2020.

The challenges have been immense across all our organizations and they are still very much upon us. But we know that through strong leadership, unwavering perseverance, an unrivaled commitment to excellence and, of course, faith, our Elizabeth Seton Children's community and all our children and families will make it through this pandemic together and be stronger for it.

I sincerely thank you for your support and look forward to sharing our 2019 highlights with you in this report. Please keep our children in your hearts and prayers as we navigate the obstacles and grasp the opportunities ahead.





A LOOK AHEAD: *Home to Stay*

A first of its kind young adult center

Elizabeth Seton Children’s is reimagining the health care landscape. With its groundbreaking new young adult center – the first of its kind in the nation – Elizabeth Seton Children’s will transform the futures of young adults living with severe medical complexities for generations to come. Here they will receive an unparalleled quality of care that is tailored to their specific medical and emotional needs and unmatched anywhere else in the world.

Until recently, children with medical complexities rarely lived beyond the age of 21. Fortunately, medical and technological advancements are allowing these children to live longer and healthier lives. For most of our young adult residents, aging out means having to be transferred to a geriatric nursing facility that is not equipped to handle their specialty medical, social or emotional needs.

We believe that this is unacceptable and that our young adults, with their tremendous determination, grace and spirit, deserve to live life to the fullest and safely become adults in a home of their own: a home to stay.

Our young adult center will be a lifetime home for 72 residents that is fully equipped with the things that make this home unique and state-of-the-art. With highly specialized, 24/7 care and the most advanced medical technologies available, it will serve as a nationwide model for caring for the complex medical conditions of young adults.





For many young people with severe medical complexity and their families, the formative transition from childhood to young adulthood is all the more precious after years of overcoming unimaginable medical hurdles. The Elizabeth Seton Young Adult Center will be a haven for so many – a place where these extraordinary individuals can truly flourish and thrive for the duration of their lives.

We are urgently seeking visionary philanthropic partners of action to make this innovative, one-of-a-kind facility a reality for young adults. We have embarked on a \$30 million Capital Campaign to realize this transformational new model of care. 
